**PROPOSED AMMENDED AND REVISED ITEMS PERTAINING TO  
BY-LAWS SIGNED AS OF MAY 29, 2008** (as revised 1st reading 9/10/12)

**Article II, Section 2, #1** to be revised and moved to Article III, Section 10

**Article II, Section 3, #1** amended to read

Nominating Committee shall consist of 2nd Vice Commander, 31 (1 Vice Commander, and Sergeant at Arms. Committee will report to assembly only nominations approved by a majority of the Committee. Nominations from the floor are in order after the Nominating Committee has reported.

**Article II, Section 3, #2** amended to read

A candidate must be a member of Post 336 in good standing for not less than one full year. To be eligible for Commander, member must have held at least a Vice Commander elective office for at least one year at anytime within Post 336.

**Article II, Section 3, add #3** to read

If membership dues are not paid by January 1 of each calendar year, said member becomes delinquent. If dues have not been paid by February 1, the member is suspended. Reinstatement may occur upon a vote of the body and payment of dues. Membership for non-payment continues until June 30, at which time the member is dropped from the roll by Constitutional mandate and the membership is forfeited.

**Article III, Section 1** add additional reading

Post Commander is elected for a term of one year. Post Commander may serve only 2 consecutive one year terms.

**Article III, Section 2** add additional wording under 1st Vice Commander

Shall be an additional Officer listed and authorized, including the Commander and Finance Officer on all signature cards and operating licenses.

**Articles III, Section 2** under 2nd Vice Commander add to #1

And other children and youth including Boy Scouts and Venture Group.

**Article III, Section 3, #2** amend to read

Shall sign and disburse checks for the Post, with backup being Post

**Commander and 1st Vice Commander.** In the absence of the Bar manager accounts, deposits, and disburses bar funds.

**Article III, Section 3** amend #3 to read

Shall obtain surety bond in the amount of \$10000.00 for all Officers and paid employees.

**Article III, Section 10** add and amend from Article II, Section 2, #1

Add as additional number

The Building Committee shall consist of three(3) elected members and the current Post Commander. One member shall be elected each year for a three(3) year term. The Committee will elect a chairperson who shall preside at all meetings.

**Article III, Section 11** amend and revise House Committee makeup to read

House Committee shall consist of seven voting members. The current Post Commander and six(6) elected Committee Members comprise the voting members. The current Post Commander votes only as a tiebreaker in the event of a tied vote by elected members. Two voting members are elected annually for a three(3) year term. In addition, there are nonvoting members who may include, if not elected as House Committee members, Post Finance Officer, Adjutant, Building Committee Chairperson, and the Bar Manager. Vacancies to the House committee shall be appointed by the Commander for the remainder of a vacated term. Such appointments are subject to approval of the body at the next scheduled monthly General meeting.

**Article IV, Section 1, #1** change "immediate outgoing" to read "immediate Past Commander"

**Article VI, Section 1, #4** amend to read

Ball Grounds rentals shall be separate from the Activity Center rental. The Ball Grounds shall be available for rental as determined through the Legion Baseball Committee with final Executive Committee approval.

**Article VI, Section 1, #5** amend to say

"use by the American Legion, Auxiliary, and Sons of the American Legion."

**Article VI, Section 1, #7** take off  
"and the Commander"

**Article VI, Section 1, #9** amend to read

Legion property shall not be removed from grounds without authorization of the Bar Manager or elected Post Officer. A signed in/out log is required prior to removal. Any item damaged or not returned shall be the responsibility of the user.

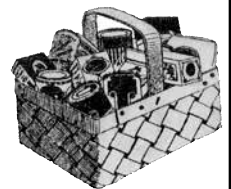

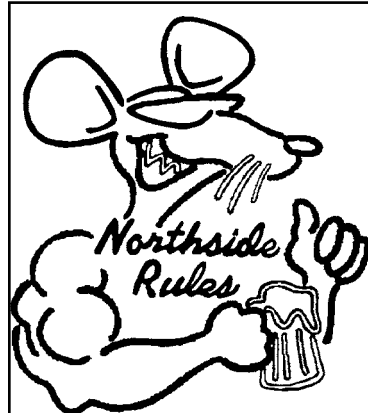
