

The flag of the United States has been modified 26 times since 1777, with the current 50-star version being the 27th design. The flag features 13 stripes, alternating red and white, and 50 white stars on a blue background. The 13 stripes represent the original 13 colonies, while the stars represent each of the 50 states. The last revision to the flag was in 1960, when a star for Hawaii was added.

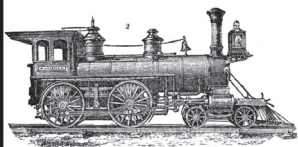

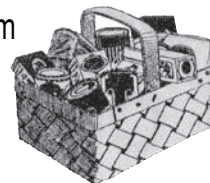
